








Ambassador of India's Message on 75th Republic day of India

Without a healthy Earth, we cannot achieve any of the Goals. It's time for Climate Action.



Soaring Higher Together

India's civil aviation industry is a source of national pride, connecting people across the nation and the world. It plays a pivotal role in unlocking India's economic potential, attracting

global businesses and tourists alike.

While most Indians travel by road or rail, the country is engaged in a major expansion of its aviation industry to serve the needs of its middle class.

India has become the third-largest domestic aviation market in the world and is expected to overtake the UK to become the third-largest air passenger market by 2024. Domestic traffic contributes around 69% of the total airline traffic in South Asia.

No nation in the world is buying as many airplanes as India. Indian carriers have around 1,500 planes on order. In New Delhi, Indira Gandhi International Airport will be ready for 109 million passengers this year, as it prepares to become the world's second busiest, behind Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport in the United States.

India is one of the fastest growing civil aviation markets in the world. Last year at the Paris Airshow, India's budget airline IndiGo placed an order of 500 A320 neo aircraft from Airbus, making the multibillion-dollar deal the largest by a single carrier in civil aviation history and the newly privatized Air India had placed an order of 470 narrow and widebody jets from both Boeing and Airbus.

The two airlines have a combined domestic market share of 81.3% in 2023 with IndiGo ferrying 56.2% of the country's passengers and Air India flying 25.1%.

India's aviation market has a "huge potential" waiting to be tapped. A rising proportion of middle-income households, healthy competition amongst Low-Cost Carriers, infrastructure build-up at leading airports and supportive policy framework have given a positive push to the aviation sector.

Indian carriers are expected to acquire more than 2200 aircrafts in the next 20 years. India is going to train 37,000 pilots and 38,000 mechanics over the next 20 years. This is one reason Boeing has announced that it will invest USD 100

Last year, ISRO launched Chandrayaan-3, and its lander named 'Vikram' and its rover named 'Pragyan' are landed on the moon's South pole.

India became the first country among the elite group to have its rover on the moon's South Pole region, which the Indian Space Research Organization believes could have traces of water. It will be a proud moment for all of us. But the mission to the moon is only a stepping stone for our future space programmes.

Here are some upcoming missions of ISRO, as stated officially on their website:

ISRO is set to surprise the world with India's first maiden voyage to the Sun. The launch of Aditya-L1, the first space-based Indian observatory to study the Sun.

India's first crewed space mission "Gagan" plans to launch a crew of three to an orbit of 400 km (250 miles) for a three-day mission before landing in Indian waters.

XPoSat (X-ray Polarimeter Satellite) Mission is India's first dedicated polarimetry mission to study cosmic X-ray sources and various dynamics of black holes, neutron stars, active galactic nuclei, and pulsar wind nebulae.

NASA-ISRO SAR (NISAR) Mission is a Low Earth Orbit (LEO) observatory that is being jointly developed by NASA and ISRO. The aim of NISAR is to map the entire globe in 12 days and aims to study Earth's ecosystems, cryosphere, solid earth science, and coastal ocean processes to address global environmental changes & natural hazards.

SPADEX or Space Docking Experiment will pave the way for future ISRO missions that require docking capabilities, such as the human spaceflight program and the in-space satellite servicing mission.

For their work in space and also on Earth, our scientists and technologists are bringing laurels to the country. An industry is built on the backs of a strong nation and a responsible industry facilitates its nation to grow. Let's keep working hard for the nation.


Hawai Sepoys. Today, it is the fourth largest Air Force in the world with a highly technical and specialized fighting force that safeguards our skies against enemy invasions.

India's Unified Payments Interface (UPI) is widely regarded as one of the most successful and transformative digital payment systems in the world. Since its launch in April 2016, UPI has witnessed remarkable growth and adoption, reshaping the way Indians make transactions and helping India to evolve into a digital economy.

Police on Call app: Helps locate the nearest Indian police station. As the name suggests, this app helps citizens to locate the nearest police station based on their location. The app has all the information like the route and distance to reach the nearest police station. It also displays contact numbers of district control room and the SP office. One can make a call using the app in the need of the hour.

DigiLocker: Digital Locker provides an ecosystem with

collection of repositories and gateways for issuers to upload the documents in the digital repositories. Digital Locker has more than 13.7 crore users and more than 562 crore documents are made available through DigiLocker from 2,311 issuer organizations.

It is a citizen engagement platform that is developed to facilitate participatory governance. Presently, more than 2.76 crore users are registered with MyGov, who participate in various activities hosted on the platform.

Unified Mobile Application for New-age Governance (UMANG) – for providing government services to citizens through mobile. More than 1668 e-Services and over 20,197



bill payment services are made available at UMANG.

Digital Village: 700 Gram Panchayats (GPs)/Village with atleast one Gram Panchayat/Village per District per State/UT are being covered under the project. The digital services being offered are Digital Health Services, Education Service, Financial Services, Skill Development, Solar panel powered street lights including Government to Citizens Services (G2C), Business to Citizen (B2C) Services.


eHospital/ Online Registration System (ORS): e-Hospital application is the Hospital Management Information System for internal workflows and processes of hospitals. Currently,

753 Hospitals have been on-boarded on e-Hospital and ORS has been adopted by 557 hospitals across the country with over 68 lakh appointments booked from ORS.


